


Design Concept



The design balances a soft, neutral base with selective accent elements that reflect the client's vibrant personality. The apartment flows around his lifestyle—hosting friends, silently showcasing his sneaker collection, and unwinding with entertainment. Large surfaces stay muted to create spaciousness, while focal accents like the red chair and black stone TV wall introduce character without overwhelming the space. 


Open plan living room view through kitchen and utility area







The Bedroom and Walk in closet



The bedroom features a bespoke seating nook, anchored by the couch. This is a deliberate placement that offers a cozy lounge area, while simultaneously providing a framed, 'gallery-style' view into the open shelving of the walk-in closet, **turning the client's sneaker collection into a personalised art feature that's subtly shown off** from the comfort of the couch.


