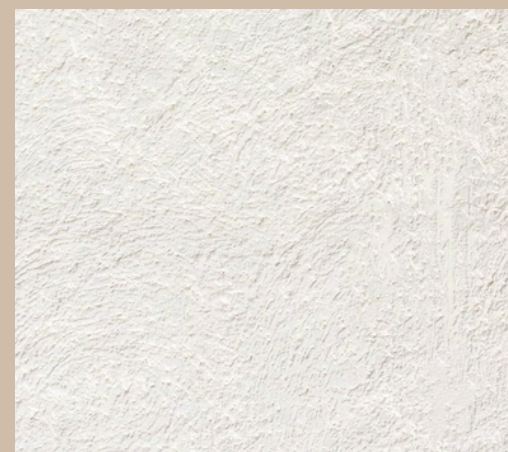
CASE STUDY 1

- Adjustable positions

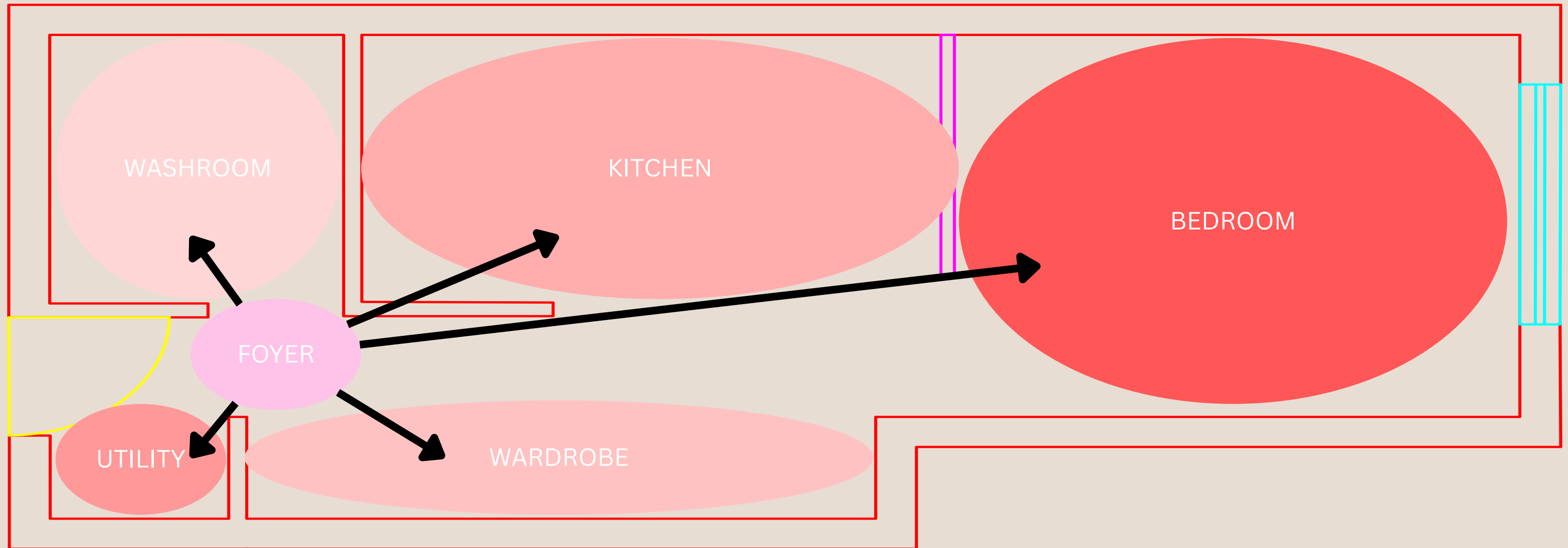

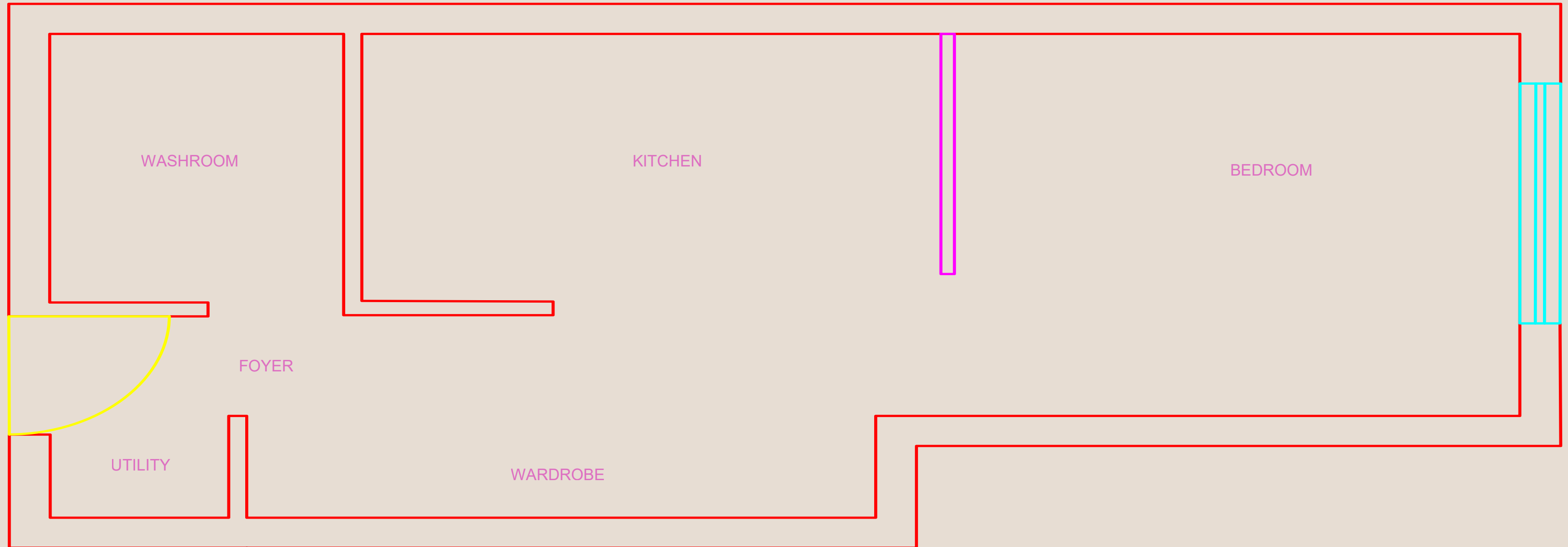

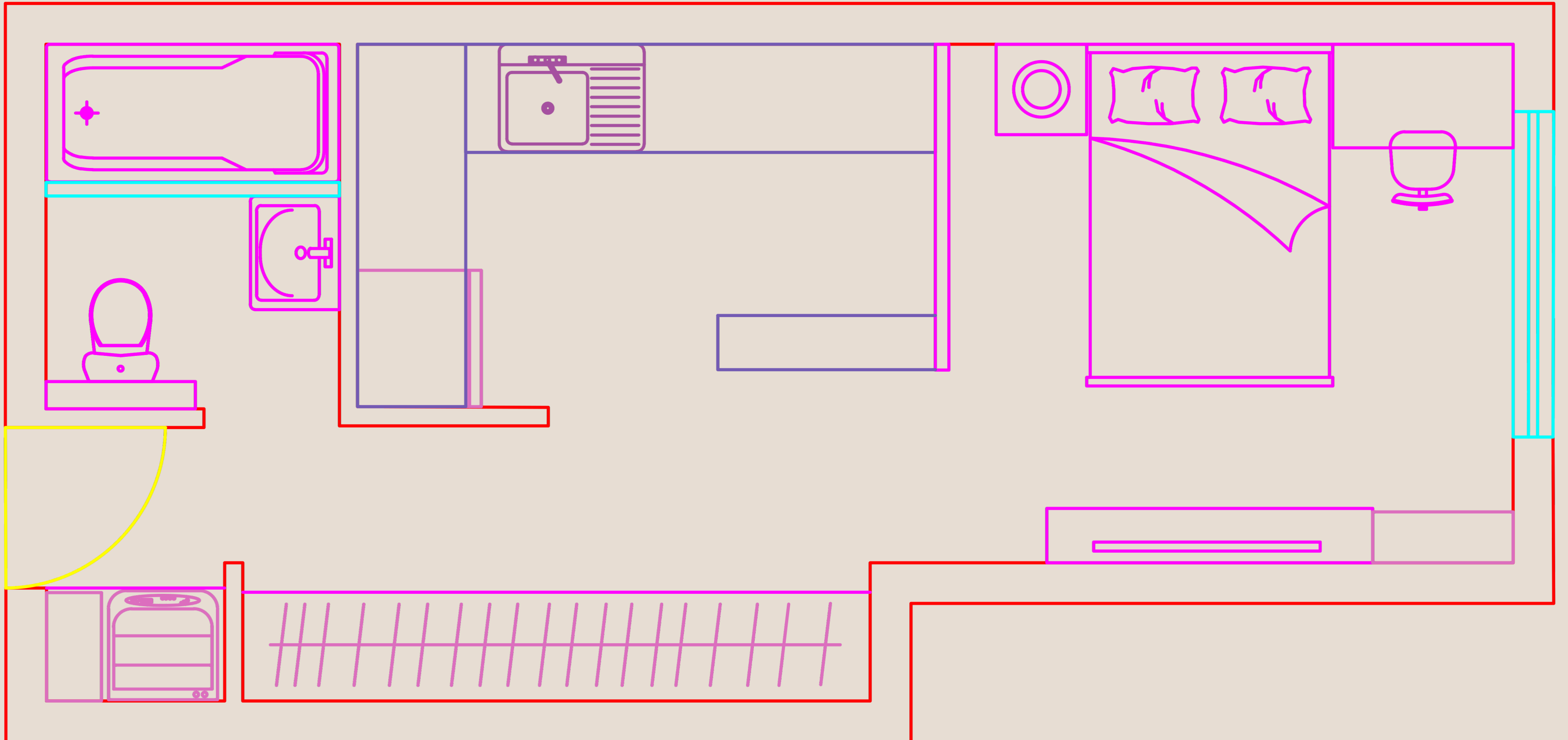
BUBBLE DIAGRAM

Evening Routine (6:30 PM – 9:30 PM)

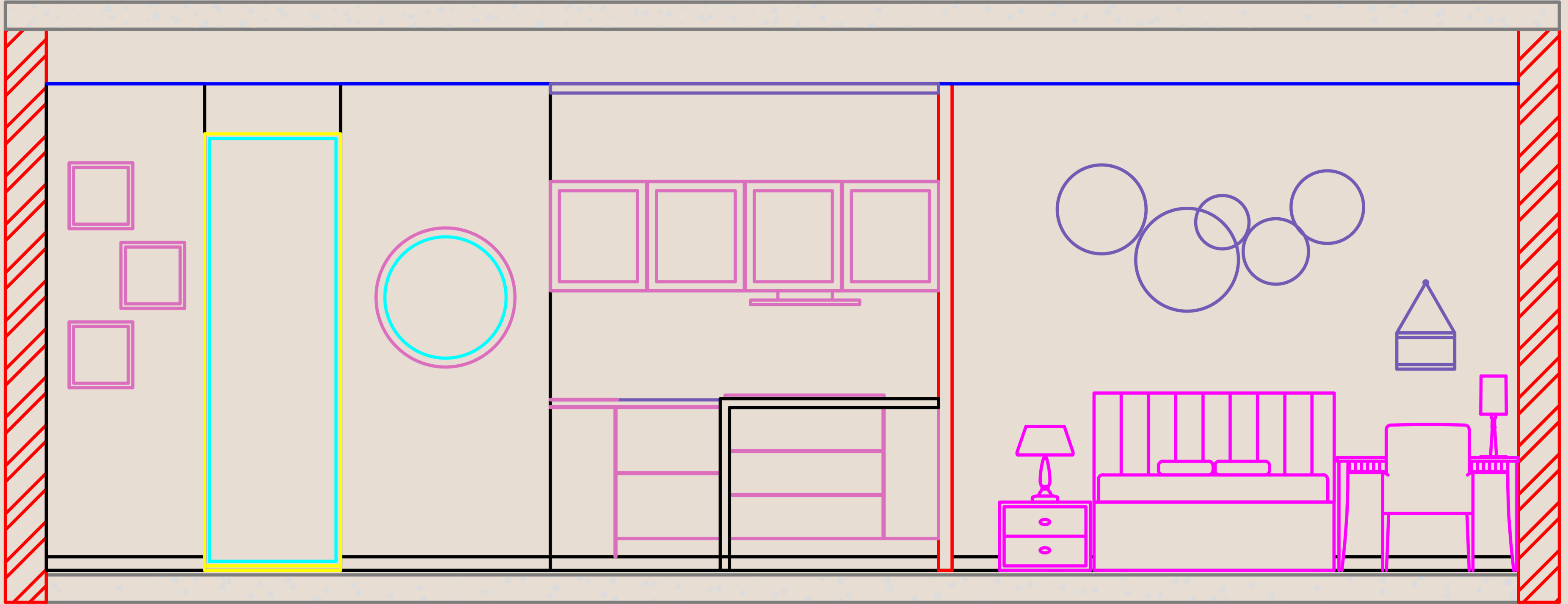

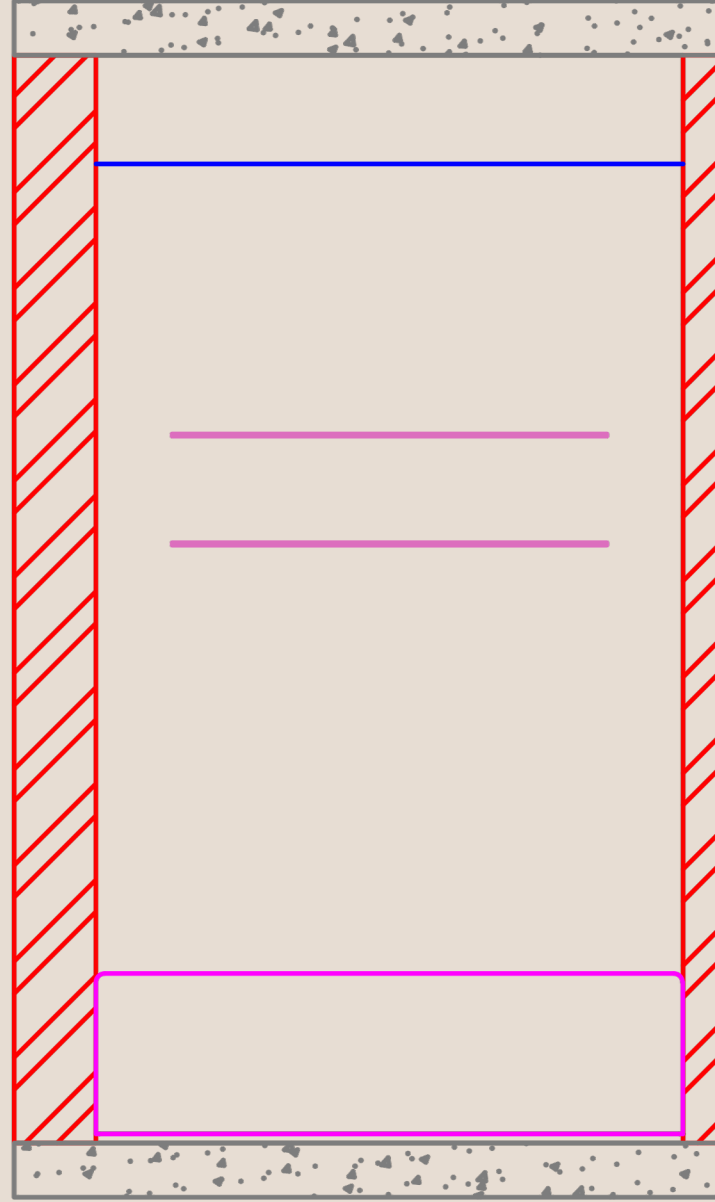
LAYOUT PLAN



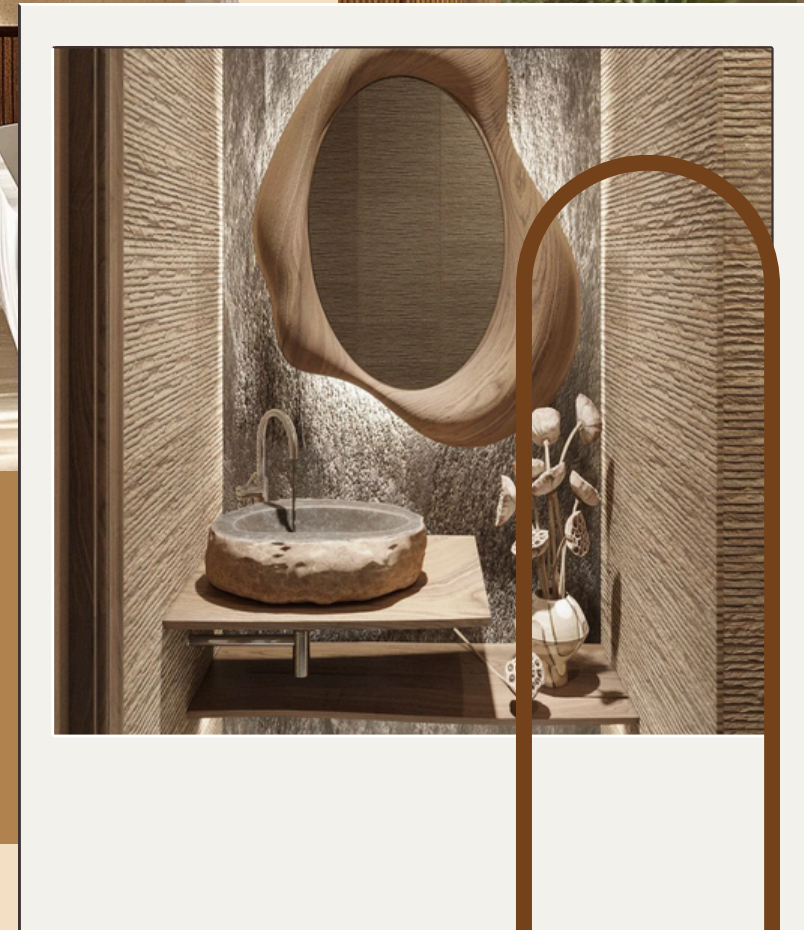
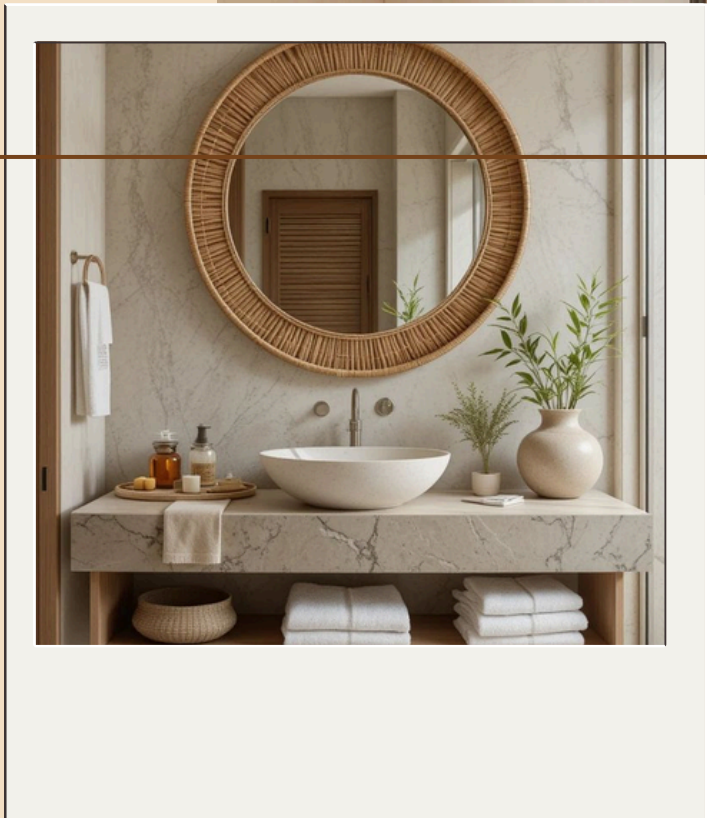
